4J Volunteer Expectations

4J Volunteer Expectations: School and Personal Property

- ✓ All school property should be used only with permission and treated with care.
- ✓ Cost of damage, loss, or theft of any school property due to negligence will be **billed to the individual responsible.**
- ✓ **Damaged, lost, or stolen personal property will not be replaced by the District.**
