1. Staff Feedback on Vision & Mission ALL

We've replaced the word encouragement with empowerment. In addition, Site council suggested a rebrand/design of the PRIDE card as illustrated below. To address the word excellence and the context of academic rigor, the definition of excellence as noted in the mission and vision statements encompasses the words used and defined in the PRIDE statement. The definition of determination is defined as "Lancers persevere to achieve", which can be used to recognize academic skills and demonstration of excellence.
